WATCH ASSOCIATION.
AS ADOPTED AT ITS AGM HELD ON 20TH APRIL 2021 BY ZOOM.

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ASSOCIATION

The amendment of 10th April 2013 to the constitution of the Association includes the following three paragraphs that need further amending:

- 2.1 To promote good citizenship and greater participation in the prevention and solution of crime to aid effective liaison between the police and public and promote the efficiency of the police and other agencies associated with crime prevention in the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding the Princes Risborough police area although including Hughenden Parish.
- 2.3 (the Association may) provide services for and on behalf of all Neighbourhood Watch Schemes in the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding the Princes Risborough police area although including Hughenden Parish.
- 3.1 Membership of the Association shall be all Neighbourhood Watch Schemes within the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding the Princes Risborough police area although including Hughenden Parish. Each member scheme shall be entitled to one individual person to represent it at General Meetings of the Association.

The new wording adopted for each of these three paragraphs is as follows:

- 2.1 To promote good citizenship and greater participation and solution of crime to aid effective liaison between the police and public and promote the efficiency of the police and other agencies associated with crime prevention in the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding Princes Risborough and Princes Risborough Rural areas.
- 2.3 (the Association may) provide services for and on behalf of all Neighbourhood Watch Schemes in the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding Princes Risborough and Princes Risborough Rural areas.
- 3.1 Membership of the Association shall be all Neighbourhood Watch Schemes within the Wycombe Local Police Area, but excluding Princes Risborough and Princes Risborough Rural areas. Each member scheme shall be entitled to one individual person to represent it at General Meetings of the Association.

A vote on the adoption of these changes will be taken at the Annual General Meeting as above.
